

Resolution No. 2013812-1

To Comply with Texas State Senate Bill 100 and State Laws Governing Elections

This document is a Repeal of Resolution No. 20111003 with Resolution No. 2013812-1 Making Changes to The City's General Elections in Coffee City, Texas municipal elections.

Whereas the wording contained in existing Resolution No. 20111003 has candidates that win their respective elected seats taking those respective offices the second Monday in January.

Whereas the previous City Council of Coffee City, Texas, by majority vote when approving Resolution No. 20111003 Changes to The City's General Election was found by current administration not to be in accordance with the terms of those newly elected taking their elected offices as provided for by Texas Secretary of State Election directives.

Whereas A Resolution of the City of Coffee City, Texas, making the Following Changes to the City's General Election Pursuant to Texas House Bill 1575 and Texas Senate Bill 100, 82nd Regular Legislature session for Changing the City of Coffee City's General Election Date From the Uniform Date Established by Law in May to the November Uniform Date Established by Law.

Whereas City Government Officials Coffee City, Texas Pursuant to Senate Bill 100 Provisions, the City Council of Coffee City with the adoption of this resolution No. 2013812-1, is now to be in compliance with State Senate Bill 100 and other applicable federal and state laws.

Therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Coffee City, Texas, that all the Municipal General Elections for Mayor and City Council shall be held on the November uniform election date established by Secretary of State and all applicable State election laws.

This Resolution was passed by a for 3 against 0 vote of City Council and approved this the 12th day of August 2013.
