

RESOLUTION # 20141208-1

ADOPTING A MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX OF 1/4 OF 1 PER CENT FOR STREET MAINTENANCE AS AUTHORIZED BY TAX CODE TITLE 3 SUBTITLE C. LOCAL SALES AND USE TAXES CHAPTER 327.

WHEREAS, Coffee City election was held on November 4, 2014 at Coffee City Community Center located at 7019 Pleasant Ridge Road, Coffee City, Texas 75763; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the election was to adopt a one quarter of one percent sales and use tax as authorized by Title 3, Chapter 327 of the Texas Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, there were 102 votes cast in favor of the municipal sales and use tax for the purpose of street maintenance.

WHEREAS, there were 93 votes cast against the municipal sales and use tax for the purpose of street maintenance.

WHEREAS, the municipal sales and use tax passed with a margin of 9 votes cast in favor of the tax.

Now, therefore, it is hereby resolved that the referendum election for a municipal sales and use tax held on November 4, 2014 did pass with a majority vote.

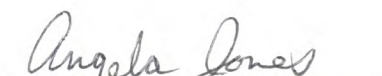
It is further resolved that a certified copy of this resolution shall be sent to the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts by certified mail.

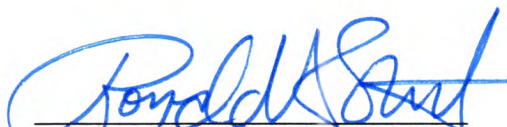
Effective date: This proposition shall be effective upon its adoption. Passed and approved this 8th day of December, 2014.

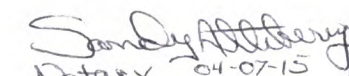
