

RESOLUTION 2010-0514 R
ADOPTING A TYPE 4B $\frac{1}{2}$ OF 1% SALES AND USE
TAX AS AUTHORIZED UNDER THE ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ACT OF 1979.

Whereas, Coffee City election was held on May 8, 2010 at City Hall located at 7019 HCR 4217, Coffee City, Texas 75763, and

Whereas, the purpose of the election was to adopt type 4b sales and use tax of one-half of one percent pursuant to the Development Act of 1979, and

Whereas, there were 65 votes cast in favor of the type 4b sales and use tax for economic development, and

Whereas, there were 32 votes cast against the type 4b sales and use tax for economic development, and

Whereas, the type 4b sales and use tax for economic development passed with a margin of 33 votes in favor of the Act.

Now therefore let it be resolved that the referendum election for a type 4b sales and use tax pursuant to the Development Corporation Act of 1979, held on May 8, 2010 did pass with a majority vote.

Effective Date: This proposition shall be effective upon its adoption.
